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The safety of pupils at PA High

PA High follows the safeguarding and child protection procedures outlined by the Birmingham Safeguarding Children Partnership and the Department for Education.

If at any time we believe that a child is in danger as a result of abuse or neglect we will seek immediate advice from children's services.

In the interest of safety of both pupils and staff we may restrain a pupil if we feel that they may endanger others or themselves.

On occasion, we may make appropriate physical contact when administering first aid or providing any emergency medical treatment.

PA High Declaration

- PA High has high expectations of all of its students and will provide a secure, supportive, inclusive environment in which each student is encouraged to grow
- PA High will provide high quality teaching and a curriculum that is appropriate to the needs of all its students including those with special needs
- PA High will keep parents informed about the progress of their child and will let them know immediately if there
 are concerns about their learning or behaviour
- Academy staff will treat all students with respect

Student declaration

- I will always do my best with my class and home work
- I will live by the school values of Excellence, Service and Integrity
- I will treat other people and PA High property with respect
- I will arrive to PA High, on time, properly equipped and in full uniform
- I will have an age-appropriate reading book with me in all lessons
- I will not bring in any banned article or substance into PA High. I understand that this includes tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs and other mind altering substances
- I will not bring knives, blades, screwdrivers, or other weapons into PA High. I understand that if I do, I may be permanently excluded
- I understand that the quality of my work and effort will lead to recognition and sanctions as set out in the behaviour policy which has been shared with me.

Parent/carer declaration

- I/We will do whatever we can to support our child's learning
- I/We will actively support the school's behaviour policy
- I/We will ensure that my/our child is properly equipped for the school day and in full uniform.
- I/We will ensure that I log into the parent app and ensure I support the completion of homework
- I/ We will ensure that my/our child attends regularly and on time. I/ We will inform the school as soon as possible of the reason for any absence
- I/ We agree to the terms in the behaviour policy
- I/We understand that the local academy committee would expect me to pay/recover any damage to the school property that has been caused by my child
- I/ We understand that the quality of my work and effort will lead to recognition and sanctions as set out in the behaviour policy which has been shared with me.
- I/ We understand that that terms set out in the behaviour policy are approved by the Local Academy Committee and are non-negotiable
- I/ We will ensure my/our child's school account for meals and trips is up to date and any concerns/support in relation to this are discussed with the school immediately
- I/ We will ensure that the school has at least two up to date contact numbers
- I/We will attend all meetings as and when they are needed
- I/We will not use social media platforms to express any dissatisfaction with the school.
- I/We support the school and its decisions, if I/We disagree then we are to contact Mr Whetton or Mr More and know that they are listening
- I/We will not challenge the school in front of my children as we know it may encourage challenge from them in school
